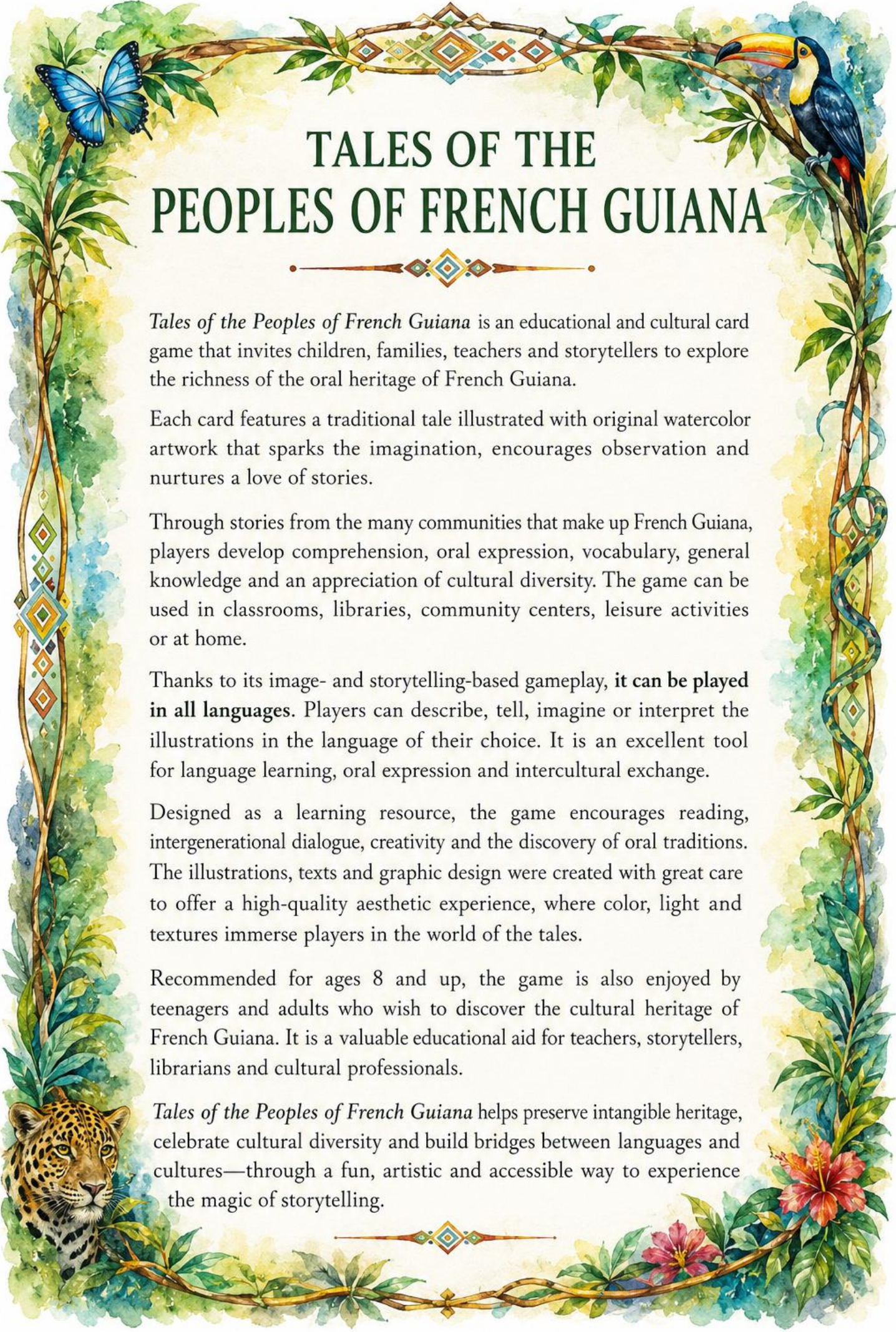




TALES OF THE PEOPLES OF FRENCH GUIANA

Designed as a learning resource, the game encourages reading, intergenerational dialogue, creativity and the discovery of oral traditions. The illustrations, texts and graphic design were created with great care to offer a high-quality aesthetic experience, where color, light and textures immerse players in the world of the tales.
